

Just Hits Code of Conduct

***Please have your child read this form as well!**

Bullying is a serious situation nowadays in schools and camps. Here at Just Hits, we want to ensure you that your child will be in an environment free of bullying, therefore we have implemented the Just Hits Code of Conduct.

There will be **NO** bullying, cursing, or negativity of any kind at the Just Hits camps. If there is a situation of bullying, the student bullying will be benched for the remainder of the camp day. If a second occurrence should take place, the camper doing the bullying will be asked to leave the camp with no refund given. If instructors witness behavior that is so egregious that it jeopardizes the welfare of the children, the instructors have the right to call the camper's parents and send the camper home immediately without a second chance.

If an act of bullying is taking place where the instructor cannot hear the act (in the outfield, etc), we advise the bullied child to approach an instructor immediately so proper action could be taken.

If campers are not willing to abide by the Just Hits Code of Conduct, then we ask that they do not attend the Just Hits Clinics. Just Hits is founded upon morals and ethics that encourage one another based on positive reinforcement rather than putting them down; we expect each camper to uphold that Conduct.

There will be no cursing by the instructors or any inappropriate conversation of any kind.
